Fr Michael Murphy RIP. In your charity, please pray for the repose of the soul of Fr Michael Murphy, who died peacefully on 11 April. A priest from the Southwark archdiocese (in Streatham Hill and as such, Fr de Malleray's neighbour in Clapham Park from 2001) Fr Murphy had retired in Warrington, his hometown. He was a great supporter of St Mary's Choir and Music. Among other involvements, he had sponsored organ formation for one of our young adults and was considering enrolling another in the organ program. He



also helped meet the costs of the LiveMass installation and sanctuary alarm at St Mary's. A member of the *Warrington Arts Council*, Fr Murphy was well known in town, where he eagerly promoted culture and social interaction.


He was rarely seen wearing clericals and some of those who knew him may not have realised his status as a retired priest. He would still help out however, as priest chaplain on cruises and, closer to us, in a parish south of Warrington. He also joined the FSSP clergy on a couple of occasions for some clergy

meals. His funeral will take place at St George's Cathedral in Southwark. We at St Mary's will also have a Mass of Requiem for him (details to be announced soon). May he rest in peace.
